FACILITY: The Dale Aquatic Center is a heated, 8 lane, 6 ft. at the starting
competition end, 25 yard pool, containing non-turbulence lane
dividers. There's a five foot deep ledge around the entire pool. The
average depth in the competition course will be 9 feet. Meet timing
will be conducted using a Colorado timing system with results
posting and scoring done using Hy-Tek Meet manager software.
There is ample deck space for spectators. Bring chairs and tents for
shade. Ample parking and basic concessions are available. If you

POOL SPECS: Certified 25 yard outdoor pool, eight lanes, non-turbulent lane lines

POOL DEPTH: North end of the pool, where the 8 & under and 6U swimmers start is 6 ft deep all the way across.
South end of the pool, starting on the west side is 12 ft for all 8 lanes

MEET START: 9:00 AM All Age Groups

WARM-UP: Warm-up times and lane assignments will be posted at the pool and each team will be required to furnish a U.S.A. Swimming-Certified Coach to monitor their warm-ups.

FORMAT: All events will be conducted as timed finals.

ELIGIBILITY: This meet is open to all invited clubs and their participating swimmers, registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and invited Non-members.

RULES: The 2010 USA Swimming rules will govern the conduct of this meet. All Officials must wear current year USA Swimming Badges on deck and present current officials' certification card at check-in. Coaches must present upon check-in, a current USA SWIMMING card Swimmers are responsible to swim in their assigned heats and lanes.

ENTRY FEES: \$2.50 for each individual event.
\$4.00 for each relay event, and
\$5.00 facility fee per swimmer.

ENTRY LIMIT: A swimmer may enter up to five (5) individual events for the meet.

TIME STANDARD: There are no qualifying standards for this meet.

ENTRY FORMS: All entry forms must be filled out completely; including full names, age as of first day of meet, USA SWIMMING registration number, and seeding time for each swimmer.

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted on a lane available basis only at double fees. All late entries will be entered with a NT.

EXCESSIVE ENTRIES: In the event of excessive entries, the meet director reserves the right to shorten the meet by eliminating the relays.

SEEDING: All individual events will be pre-seeded.

All relay teams must have a positive check-in 45 minutes prior to the session the relay(s) are entered in.

CHECK-IN: Coaches must check in at the clerk of course table no later than 30 minutes before each session in order to register late entries and deck seeded event swimmers.

SCORING: 7-5-4-3-2-1 for individual events, double points for relays. All 13-14 year old swimmers entered in the senior events will be scored separately from swimmers over 14 years of age as of the date of the meet.

9-7-6-5-4-3-2-2- for individual events if 8 lanes are run, double points for relays. All 13 & 14 year old swimmers entered in the senior events will be scored separately from swimmers 14 years of age and older

AWARDS: 1st - 6th Place High Point Awards for each age group.
Medals will be presented for 1st – 6th place for individual events
Awards will be presented for 1st - 6th place for all relays.
If the number of entries dictate it- we will run 8 lanes and provide Awards 1st- 8th Place.
Team Trophies (excluding host team SC) will be presented for 1st- 4th place.

A 1st- 3rd Place High Point Award will be awarded to 10U and 11&12 Girl and Boy who compete exclusively in ALL Senior Events.
